

FACTS**WHAT DOES SCION LENDING DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?****Why?**

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- **Social Security Number** and **Assets**
- **Income** and **Employment information**
- **Credit history** and **Mortgage rates and payments**

How?

All financial companies need to share **Customers** personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their **Customers** personal information; the reasons **Scion Lending** chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Scion Lending protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also utilize shredding services for all offices locations.
How does Scion Lending collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Apply for a loan or ▪ Provide account information or ▪ Provide your mortgage information or ▪ Give us your employment history or ▪ Give us your income information We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes — information about your creditworthiness ▪ affiliates from using your information to market to you ▪ sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See Other Important Information below for more on your rights, under State Law.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Our affiliates include companies with a common ownership interest of Scion Lending financial companies, such as First Source Title Agency, Inc.</i>
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Scion Lending does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Scion Lending does not jointly market.</i>

VT: We will not share your information with affiliates without your consent. NV: State privacy laws permit us to make marketing calls to existing customers.
